



What is Indicator


Indicator 11 measures the percentage of students with initial parental consent to evaluate who were evaluated and had eligibility determined within 60 school days.



- For Parentally Placed Non Public students, the resident district is the district whose boundaries include the area where the nonpublic school is physically located.
- Indicator 11 data is required for all students.
- Failure to address Indicator 11 for approval records in I-Star will result in errors.







How is Indicator Data Collected in I-Star?

Step 1: <u>Initial</u> Eligibility Determination Meeting is held.

Step 2: Regardless of the outcome of the eligibility, an approval record is added to Star for the student.

Step 3: For a public student that does not receive services, the Fund Code is "U". For a nonpublic student, the Fund Code is "N".










- Fund Code U is used for all public school students who:
 - Have been initially evaluated
 - Have had their eligibility determined
 - Are NOT receiving services
- When Fund Code U is used, the reason the student is not receiving services must also be reported:
 - 01 Student is NOT eligible
 - 02 Student is eligible but parent refuses services
 - 04 Student is eligible pending placement
 - 05 Student is not of eligible age (2 years old)









Indicator 11 Acceptable Timeline Exceptions for Compliance: For students with initial parental consent to evaluate and had eligibility determined beyond 60 school days, the following are acceptable timelines for compliance: • 01 Parent failure or refusal to produce the student for evaluation caused a delay in the eligibility determination timeline. • 02 The student enrolled in district after parental consent was received in another district, but before eligibility could be determined. • 07 Eligibility determination delayed due to the parent's unavailability and/or inability to attend the initial eligibility determination meeting when all eligibility assessments were completed within the 60-school-day timeline. (Districts using this coode should maintain documentation locally regarding the eligibility assessment completion dates and the attempts made to schedule the eligibility determination meeting with the parent. As necessary, ISBE may request further information from districts). • 09 Timeline properly extended in accordance with 34 CFR §300.309(c), where the evaluation timeline is extended by mutual written agreement of the student's parents and a group of qualified professionals in the determination of a specific learning disability (SID.) In accordance with 23 III. Adm. Code 226 130, effective with the 2010-11 school year, a process that determines how a student responds to scientific, research-based interventions must be used as part of the evaluation procedures for determining SLD eligibility. A timeline extension using this code (i/9) may not have the effect of denying a student's FAPE and is not allowed for suspected disabilities other than SLD. If this code is used, the extended timeline date cannot be transmitted with the I-Star record • 10 Student's evaluation days are calculated based on the school calendar (vs. the district calendar) and are within the 60 school-day timeline for initial

Indicator 11 Delays Resulting in a Finding of Noncompliance: For students with initial parental consent to evaluate and had eligibility determined beyond 60 school days, the following are delays in meeting the timeline that result in noncompliance: • 03 Lack of personnel resources to complete the evaluation caused delay, 02 The student enrolled in district after parental consent was received in another district, but before eligibility could be determined. • 04 District was unable to ensure that eligibility determination procedures and practices were completed in a timely manner. • 05 District failure to complete the eligibility determination due to summer break and lack of personnel or resources during the summer. • 06 District failure to complete the eligibility determination due to hearing, vision, or other medical issues. • 08 Initial eligibility determination timeline is actually within the 60-school-day timeline but appears to be beyond 60 school days due to changes that have not yet been made to the district's official calendar submitted through IWAS (e.g., emergency or snow days have not been updated in the district's official school calendar). This option is only applicable before May 1 of each school year. Choosing this code after May 1 of a particular school year will result in an error. Thus, the district's official calendar must be updated, and this reason code must be changed before the end of the school year. Please note: Per the Illinois School Code (105 ILCS S/14-8.02), in instances when a student is referred for evaluation with fewer than 60 school days left in the school oyear, the eligibility determination must be made prior to the first day of the following school year. Initial eligibility determination school are not of the reason codes above to avoid an error.
