iePoint > 2015.1.1 Released

Harrisburg Project released **iePoint > 2015.1.1** to clients last week. **iePoint >** will automatically receive this update upon logging into the program, however, an **iePoint > Manager** will have to complete the update process.

The new Assessment 3744-O IEP forms and general maintenance items are included in this update.

Transmission report procedures have also changed in this release. You will notice that the prompt to print your 'Transmitted to ISBE' report will be titled 'Preview' if you print it before completing the entire transmission process. If you print the report after your data has been completely transmitted, you will be printing the 'Official' report. This provides you additional accuracy for data retention, since the 'Official' report absolutely verifies that no data changes were made amid the transmission process.

You may transmit as many times as necessary until the end of business on Friday, May 8th. If you are a member of a Super Site, your Super Site may have designated an earlier due date.
