Fund Codes DEF Student Claim Error Emails

Harrisburg Project will be sending daily emails to districts that have *Student Claims* errors for Regular Term Fund Codes DEF records. These errors must be corrected by the end of business Friday, July 30th. No additional edits will be allowed after this data pickup is complete.

In the event a claim record is not going to be submitted, please open the *Student Claim* record and uncheck the 'Include Claim' box. This will eliminate future reminder emails.

Student Approval Error Emails

Beginning this week, Harrisburg Project will send emails to districts that have *Student Approval* errors for Fund Codes A, K, L, P, N or U records.

These errors must be corrected by the end of business Friday, July 30th. No additional edits will be allowed after this data pickup is complete.

July 30th Data Collection Reminder

The following data will be collected on Friday, July 30th:

- Student Approval - Fund Codes A, K, L, P, N and U
- Student Claims - Fund Codes D, E, and F (Regular Term)
- Personnel Approval
- Indicators 11 and 13

End of Year Tasks - Before Start New Year is Completed

Once the *Student Claims* and *Personnel Approval* data entry is complete for the 2020-2021 school year, it is time to do 'housekeeping' in your data before ISBE completes *Start New Year*.

Take a few minutes to review the following situations in I-Star:

- Enter an *End Date* and *Exit Code* for graduated students.
- Enter an *End Date* and *Exit Code* for student not returning in the 2021-2022 school year.
- **Do Not Delete** *Personnel Approval* records for staff members not returning in 2021-2022; this will be in the 2021-2022 school year.

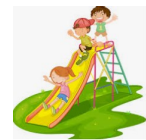

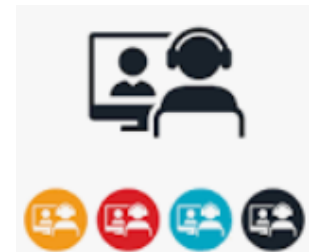
