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### **December 1 Child Count Snapshot Continues**

There are only three December 1 Child Count Snapshots remaining. The FINAL December 1 Child Count Snapshot will be Wednesday, February 23<sup>rd</sup>. No edits will be allowed after this final data collection. These next three weeks are critical! Be sure that the data is accurate and complete for your district!

The student data collected during the weekly December 1 Child Count Snapshot should be reviewed by exporting the 'Child Count Snapshot by Resident District' report. The following How-To Snippet video will walk you through exporting this report:

### **Child Count Certification Instructions**

The final requirement of the December 1 Child Count is the data certification. The data certification will be completed by the district superintendent or authorized representative. The December 1 Child Count data to certify will be collected during the final data collection on February 23<sup>rd</sup>.

The estimated opening of the December 1 Child Count Certification is March 11<sup>th</sup>. Be prepared for this last step, review the following instructions and video:



#### Fund Code N - When to Create Record

We continue to have many questions about usage of *Fund Code* N for eligible students that stop receiving special education services. If you enter *Exit Code* 10 or 12 for students in I-Star, use the flowchart below to determine whether a student should have a subsequent *Fund Code* N record.

## Updating Disability N on Student Approval Record

ISBE does not allow a direct edit to the disability of N on a *Student Approval* record. Once a student turns 10, this disability is no longer accepted. 
