FACTS & Personnel Approval Due Wednesday 3/18

Due to the special education pupil errors just being released, ISBE has granted an extension for the next required *FACTS* and *Personnel Approval* transmissions. The **REVISED DUE DATE IS WEDNESDAY, MARCH 18, 2015**. "It is critical that all errors identified are addressed and resolved in this upcoming transmission as ISBE will be compiling a preliminary December 1, 2014 child count for the federal Department of Education as well as updating our IDEA Part B state maintenance of effort calculations. Please take the necessary time to ensure all students with disabilities who are receiving services as of December 1, 2014 are reported." Don't wait until the last minute, transmit your data once it is error free! Remember, you may transmit as many times as necessary until the end of business on Wednesday, March 18th.
