### **iePoint > 2016 Coming Soon!**

Harrisburg Project is gearing up to release *iePoint > 2016* in the next few weeks. Here is a preview of the changes coming this school year:

- New Indicator 13 Checklist and Data Collection

- Elimination of Category X (Additional Serving Locations)
- Elimination of Category Y (Out-of-State Resident Districts)
- Elimination of PPNP Set-Aside District

This reflects the upcoming changes to the *FACTS Approval* manual published by ISBE. Category X and Category Y entities will be deactivated this school year and will generate an error for 2015-2016 *FACTS* records. Category X and Category Y entities will be marked inactive as of 07/31/2015. This change should be visible today.

In the case of Home/Hospital or an undetermined serving location, the serving location would either be where the student attends for educational instruction or where he/she would attend if he/she were educated at a school in his/her serving district.

### **IWAS Authorization Deadline - October 8<sup>th</sup>**

The deadline for completing the IWAS Authorization is Thursday, October 8<sup>th</sup>. To verify if the IWAS Authorization has been completed by the District Superintendent, click the following link (the Hbug Login and Password is required to view this report).

If the district name is appearing in **BLACK**, the IWAS Authorization has been completed. If you are still receiving the IWAS Authorization error in *iePoint >*, go to *File -> System Maintenance -> Refresh Common Data* to receive the most up to date IWAS Authorization information.

If the district name is appearing in **RED**, the District Superintendent should be contacted.

Remember, there is a 24-48 hour turnaround time for a completed IWAS Authorization to show up on the IWAS Authorization List or in *iePoint >*.
