## FINAL December 1 Child Count - Wednesday, Feb. 24th

This is it! The FINAL December 1 Child Count will be picked up at the end of business, Wednesday, February 24th. Effective Thursday, February 25th, the *Student Approval* data will be locked for editing.

The focus for the next four (4) days should be completing the *Student Approval* data in I-Star. To ensure that all students receiving services on or before December 1 have an active 'Approved' *Student Approval* record, the following reports in I-Star should be reviewed:

- Student -> Errors-> Student Approval Errors Listing
- Student -> Approvals -> Approvals Reported for Child Count
- Student -> Approvals -> Child Count Snapshot by Resident District (This report will not change when corrections are made to the data. It will show the preliminary data picked up on February 19<sup>th</sup>.)
